The story can be factually based or totally fictional. Stories can be submitted in writing, or orally on CD, DVD or cassette tape. Submissions will be accepted in Welsh or English.

Deadline for entries:
Tuesday, June 17 2008

Rules of the Short Story Competition

1. The competition is open to those employed within the social care sector, service users and carers in Mid Wales.
2. All entries need to be received at the offices of StrataMatrix, Plas Gogerddan, Aberystwyth, SY23 3EB by Tuesday, 17 June 2008.
3. A condition of entry is that all participants agree that the stories submitted may be utilised by the Mid Wales Social Care Partnership in promotional material to raise awareness of the importance of the Care Sector in Wales.
4. The judging panel will be nominated by the Strategic Group of the Mid Wales Social Care Partnership and will meet in June to adjudicate on the entries and decide on the winning entry.

5. The winners will be notified in writing by Friday, 18 July.
6. The winner will be presented with the prize during National Eisteddfod week in Cardiff, August 2-9 2008. It is a condition of entry that the winner attends this presentation.
7. Entrants can submit no more than 2 stories each.
8. Prize monies will be £1,000.

Exclusions:

Family members related to the Strategic Committee Members of the Mid Wales Social Care Partnership, members of the Judging Panel or employees of StrataMatrix Ltd. are ineligible to enter the competition.
